Spring 2009 Honors Lists

A total of 320 students made the Honors lists for the Spring 2009 semester. We had 86 students with a 4.0 term GPA on the Chancellor's list, 108 students on the Dean's List, and 126 students on the Honor Roll. This is an increase of 17 students from Fall 2008 and 43 more than Spring 2008.



Advanced Composition Exam

The Advanced Composition Exam will be held this summer on July 15th (deadline to sign up was July 1st). Students are eligible to take the exam after earning 30 credits and completion of ENGL 1013 and ENGL 1023 (but must be taken before the student has acquired 96 credit hours). Students not gaining exemption from ENGL 2003 must register for the course before the last semester of their senior year.
