Remember, if you have received a notice that one of your students is required to participate in the Academic Enhancement Program, please do not remove their advising hold before John Kelly has contacted you. By now, you should have received a State Minimum Core report for each of your students. If you are missing any reports, you can process one through the Faculty Center in ISIS. Follow these simple steps:

Click on the Advisement Tab

Under Student Details Menu - Select "Degree Progress" and click the ">>" to the right Academic Institution - Select "University of Arkansas"

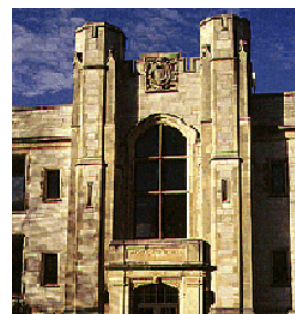
Report Type - Select "State Minimum Core Check"

Click "Go"

As you know, the Dean's Office tracks degree progress and sends emails to students (and the advisor is copied) who have completed 85 credit hours or more. Remember all files are reviewed annually and it is not necessary for the student to have a degree audit in person unless they have specific questions. Of course, if you identify any discrepancies with our findings, then please contact us immediately.

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Student Health Fair

Variable Credit Hour Class Information

If one of your students enrolls in a variable hour course for the wrong number of hours, there is a function in ISIS that allows **them** to correct this, but *only during student registration*. If they go to "add a class" in ISIS, select the class on the class schedule -- at the bottom there will be an "edit" option. Hours may be increased or decreased here. If they have difficulty, please don't hesitate to have them call the Dean's Office.
