Dear Colleagues,

The Retention Task Force began work this summer on the initiatives defined at the retreat in March. One goal was to establish a club meeting time during the day. After reviewing the schedule of Bumpers College courses, the task force found that it is very realistic for clubs to have a monthly meeting during the 12:30-1:20 p.m. time slot. Scheduling club meetings within this time slot would provide several opportunities for each club. They include:

- eliminating the annual scramble to coordinate schedules and avoid conflicts with other clubs in finding meeting times
- students would have a better opportunity to join more than one club
- clubs that tend to draw students of similar interests could recruit more members (students wouldn't have to choose between clubs)
- meetings wouldn't conflict with students' evening work schedules
- the designated time slot would not prevent any group from sponsoring an evening event or trip

having a preset meeting time that is consistent from semester to semester would allow interested students to schedule courses around club meetings

If you are a club advisor, you recently received an email from Dr. Nick Anthony about this information. One of the task force members will be contacting you in the very near future to provide you with additional information and ask you for your feedback.

Clubs are a good way for students to get engaged socially and learn more about their major. Ultimately, finding a connection will encourage students to persist and hopefully graduate. 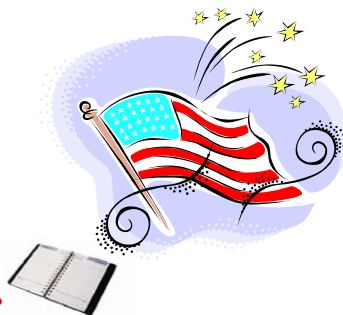
The Fall 2007 offering of the exam will be held on Wednesday, September 19th.
