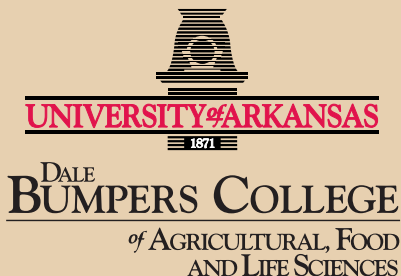

- Current and transfer students who have completed no more than 90 hours with a college GPA of at least 3.25.
