

Fayetteville Evening Lions Club Scholarship Application

The Fayetteville Evening Lions Club offers financial support to qualified persons pursuing a program of instruction at the University of Arkansas. The stipend available for each semester of the academic year ranges from \$600.00–\$750.00. The grants-in-aid may be renewed subject to academic performance and funds available to support the program.

Eligibility Requirements: The applicant must be:

- [1] a resident of Washington County, Arkansas.
- [2] Be registered in a minimum of 12 credit hours leading toward the baccalaureate degree during the semester to be covered by the scholarship.

How to apply:

[a] The applicant should submit a letter of application, 150–200 words in length, stating goals and aspirations in his/her educational career.

[b] A copy of the applicant's transcript and a completed copy of the application form (including financial information as indicated on the application form) should accompany the letter.

[c] The applicant should request 2–3 letters of recommendation from teachers, former teachers or others and/or the major advisor of the student.

[d] Deadline for submission:
Fall semester---May 20
Spring semester---Dec. 30

The application materials must be received by the scholarship committee chair no later than the deadline date; materials postmarked on the deadline date are not sufficient.
