Section 5: Fine Arts and Humanities (6 hrs from 2 sets below). Sub-section 5.1: Fine Arts. Courses include ARCH, ARHS, ARTS, COMM, DANC, DRAM, HUMN, LARC, MLIT.

Sub-section 5.2: Humanities A (Philosophy). Courses include PHIL 2003, PHIL 2103, PHIL 2203, PHIL 3103.

Sub-section 5.3: Humanities B (Literature). Courses include CLST 1003, CLST 1013, HUMN 1124, HUMN 2124, WLIT 1113, WLIT 1123.

Sub-section 5.4: Humanities C (Foreign Language, Gender). Courses include FLAN 2003, HUMN 2003, HUMN 3923.

Section 6: Social Sciences: Choose 9 hrs from 3 sets of courses. Courses include PSYC 2003, SOCI 2013, RSOC 2603, AGEC 1103, ECON 2023, AGEC 2103, ECON 2013.

Section 7: Departmental Core (18 hrs). Courses include AGEC 2303, AGEC 3303, AGEC 3403, AGEC 3503, AGEC 4143, AGEC 4613.

Section 8: Specialization (27 hrs). Choose one from AGEC 2143, WCOB 1023. and take AGEC 3373, AGEC 3313, AGEC 3413. and choose one from AGEC 4113, AGEC 4373. and choose one from AGEC 4313, AGEC 4323.

Nine hrs of electives from MATH, STAT, AGEC, or courses in WCOB (e.g., ACCT, ECON, FINN, ISYS, MKTG, MGMT), or courses in Bumpers AFLS College.

Section 9: Bumpers AFLS College Broadening Electives (9 hrs). Courses include PHIL 2003, PHIL 2103, PHIL 2203, PHIL 3103.

Section 10: General Electives (20 hrs). To be used for a minor if desired. Students who have not taken 39 hrs of 3000 and 4000 level courses in other segments of the concentration must fulfill the requirements in the General Electives.
