¹Exemption may be earned by proficiency exam, see University catalog. If not exempt, ENGL 2003 must be taken before the last semester of your senior year. If students choose to take the exemption exam, it must be taken within 30-96 hours. Twelve hours in Communications, including three hours of communication (speech) required regardless of exemption.

²ETEC 2001, 2002L required for admission to MAT program. GHES majors may take an equivalent 3 hour computer course.

³ Students may substitute two courses in general chemistry for CHEM 1074 and 1071L, if desired.

⁴ Students wishing to qualify for the MAT need 3 credit hours of English Literature, World Literature or American Literature and 3 credit hours of Western Civilization or World Civilization: CIED 1002, 1011, 3023, 3033 and VOED 3001, 4002, 4013 (note number ², above). In addition, students must meet admission requirements of the Graduate School and successfully complete PRAXIS I exams.

* 39 total hours of upper level courses are required for all HESC majors. The number of upper level elective hours needed for GHES majors depends on whether HESC 1213 or HESC 3204 is chosen in the HESC section above.
