Note: To enroll in upper level courses in WCOB requires the following as prerequisites regardless of concentration: WCOB 1120 Comp Competency or equiv (CSCE 1012 or AGME 2903), WCOB 1023 Business Foundations, WCOB 1033 Data Anal and Interpretation.
